Stage 2 – Inner Loop Road Race

Announcements:

Teams are not allowed to use large vans for Time Trial follow vehicles.

Teams that plan to use a second follow vehicle, other than their normal caravan vehicle, shall meet with Andy McCord, UCI Commissaire President, near the start prior to 8:45am. The vehicle and the driver shall be present.

Riders are to use one number, placed on the lower back.

There will be heavy side traffic 5.1 miles (8.2 km) from the start. Please watch out for traffic.

A neutral pit provided by Shimano will be provided 4.4 miles (7.1 km) from the start. This is accessible from both directions. A neutral pit will also be available at the turnaround.

Follow car deviation will be to the left prior to the fencing for the finish.

Riders are to finish in the right-hand lane. Please keep the area around the start/finish area clear.

Teams shall insure placement of numbers are such that there is a separation between the two numbers so that the numbers can be read more easily at the finish.
